



### **OUR DOG POLICY :**

We are dog owners ourselves so dogs are very welcome in Flint and White Cottages, and we know how enjoyable it is for your pet to share your holiday.

So that we can maintain a happy environment for both dogs and future guests would you please kindly adhere to the following conditions:

- Dogs are not allowed on any furniture- unless protective covering is placed over the sofas & chairs ( our dogs are not allowed on the furniture but we know that if your pet is used to this at home it is difficult to stop them ! ) also dog hair is exceptionally difficult to remove from sofas – so please bring throws/ sheets etc with you if needed ( to cover the whole sofa/chairs please ). Our quilts and throws are not to be used for this purpose.
- Dogs are not to be left alone in the cottage- unless they are confined to the kitchen area AND you are sure of their good behaviour ( i.e. not destructive – or barking )
- Dogs are **not** allowed upstairs – this is without exception due to the additional cleaning required AND the inevitably of dog hair settling on bed linen- again very difficult to remove entirely.
- The garden must be left clean on your pet's departure
- Please ensure your pet's vaccinations and flea treatments are upto date before arrival
- We welcome Guide & Assistance dogs
- Maximum usually 3 however contact us to discuss if more pets !
- We reserve the right to invoice for any damage caused by your pet

We will consider individual requirements so please contact us with any query

We provide a fixed stair gate to make it easy to restrict your pet to the kitchen area when required.

Please note that the stairs are too narrow to fit a standard stair gate across securely at the bottom of the stairs, so if you need a barrier to stop your pet accessing upstairs please bring something suitable with you

Both Flint and White Cottages have secure fenced gardens.

Please note that Sheringham has “ Blue Flag “ beach status, and restricts dogs from certain areas of beach between 1<sup>st</sup> May- 30<sup>th</sup> September – however a large area of beach is still accessible to pets a short walk along the promenade ( to the right ) past the beach huts, a walk here is still accessible when the tide is in.

On the way back “The Funky Mackerel “ Cafe welcomes well behaved dogs on leads , and is open most of the year.

Sheringham is very “ dog friendly “ and various pubs will allow dogs on leads.
